



PATHWAYS – PERFORMERS

The intention of Pathways is to foster experiences emulating career musicians who give back to the community through performances. The program will:

- Offer young musicians (“Performers”) the experience of collaborating on a concert program as well as the experience of refining a program through multiple performance opportunities at elementary schools in Salt Lake County
- Offer young professionals (“Panelists”) the experience of mentoring young musicians and designing outreach programs with the support of three established non-profit music organizations

Performer Eligibility

- This program is for pianists 7th-12th grade who are playing at a high artistic level

Performer Expectations

Six performers will be selected through an audition and interview process. Performers will be assigned to either the Fall Team or Spring Team. The performers will be mentored and coached by the Panelists to present three outreach performances and a showcase concert at Rose Wagner Performing Arts Center. Performers are required to attend two rehearsals with the panelists and perform at all three outreach performances that will take place during school hours plus the showcase on April 25, 2020. Performers need to perform/engage with audience for 15-20 minutes at each performance.

Important Dates

- *August 15:* application deadline
- *September:* audition and interview at Daynes Music
- *September – October:* two rehearsals with Fall Team at Daynes Music (90 minutes each)
- *November:* three outreach performances presented by Fall Team
- *December – January:* two rehearsals with Spring Team at Daynes Music (90 minutes each)
- *February:* three outreach performances presented by Spring Team
- *April:* Showcase Rehearsal at Rose Wagner Performing Arts Center (90 minutes)
- ***April 25, 2020– 2PM:*** Pathways Showcase at Rose Wagner Center (120 minutes)

Application Requirements– due August 15, 2019

Interested performers must prepare and submit the following information requested on the online application at utahmta.org:

- Contact information, teacher information, media release
- Audition repertoire (15-20 minutes)
- Describe why you want to be a Pathways Performer
- \$25 Application Fee (waived for students of UMTA members; requires MTNA membership number)
